When they **found** him on the other side of the
sea,
they said to him, “Rabbi, when did you **come**
here?”

Jesus answered them,
“Truly, truly, I say to you,
you are **seeking** me, not because you saw **signs**,
but because you ate your **fill** of the loaves.

John 6:25-26 (ESV)

Do I seek Jesus only
in times of **crisis**?

Then they said to him, “What must we **do**,
to be doing the works of God?”

Jesus answered them, “This is the **work of God**,
that you **believe in** him whom he has sent.”

John 6:27-29 (ESV)

Do not work for the food that perishes,
but for the food that endures to eternal life,
which the **Son** of Man will give to you.

For on him God the **Father** has set his **seal.**”

John 6:27 (ESV)

Have I been working hard **for** God,
not doing the **work of God**?

“Then what **sign** do you do,
that we may see and **believe** you?
What **work** do you perform?

Our fathers ate the **manna** in the wilderness;
as it is written,
‘He gave them **bread from heaven** to eat.’”

John 6:30-31 (ESV)

Jesus then said to them,
“Truly, truly, I say to you, it was not **Moses**
who gave you the bread from heaven, but
my **Father** gives you the true bread from
heaven.

For the **bread of God** is
he who comes **down** from heaven
and gives **life** to the world.”

John 6:30-31 (ESV)

What **convinces** me?

They said to him, “Sir, give us this bread
always.”

Jesus said to them, “I am the bread of life;
whoever comes to me shall not hunger,
and whoever believes in me shall never thirst.

But I said to you that
you have seen me and yet do not believe.

John 6:34-36 (ESV)

All that the **Father gives** me will come to me,
and **whoever comes** to me I will never **cast out**.

For I have come down from heaven, not to
do my **own will** but the will of him who **sent me**.

And this is the will of him who sent me, that
I should **lose** nothing of all that he has given me,
but **raise** it up on the last day.

John 6:37-39 (ESV)

For this is the will of my Father,
that everyone who **looks** on the Son
and **believes** in him should have eternal life,
and I will **raise** him up on the last day.”

John 6:40 (ESV)

How does Jesus' **promise**
in this passage
bring me **comfort**?
